

7. Introduction

The workshop on "Web Application Prototype Development Using Bootstrap" was organized for the final year students of department of Computer Science and Computer Application. The notice of the same was provided to the student through flyer (Annexure 2). The technical session was conducted by the Mr. Sanjug Sonowal (Freelancer, Website Developer). Mr. Sanjug is also the alumni of Department of BBA (CA), SSR College of Arts, Commerce and Science, Silvassa.

8. Workshop Objectives:

The objectives of the workshops is to train students in following aspects

- a) Build responsive design using Bootstrap
- b) Design layouts adhering to a baseline grid and fluid grid
- c) Understand how the HTML, CSS and JavaScript components of Bootstrap work
- d) Create responsive webpages
- e) Customise and optimise a Bootstrap installations and plugins

9. Outline of Workshop

Workshop on "Web Application Prototype Development Using Bootstrap" aims to impart technical and practical knowledge regarding Web Application development using Bootstrap to students of bachelor degree in Computer Science and Computer Application. The meeting was started at morning 11:00 am with Saraswati Vandana. Mrs. Jinil Jacob (Assistant Professor) introduced the theme of the workshop. Dr. Rajeev Singh (Principal



SSR Arts, Commerce and Science, Silvassa, Dadra and Nagar Haveli) has given inaugural speech and inaugurated the workshop. During his speech, he guided students regarding importance of workshops and training programs in early student life. He congratulated the all faculty members for the organizing the workshop.

The two days technical session was conducted by the Mr. Sanjug Sonowal. He started the workshop with the Current trends of web development and bootstrapwith its advantages and disadvantages. He explained the topic with practical implementation and showed some live examples where bootstrap has been used. He explained them the benefits and challenges it will bring to day-to-day activities and how it can benefit them irrespective of their branch. He discussed the importance, usefulness and impact of this new technology in today's digital world. He briefed the students about the types of validation, plugins, components, basic hardware and software requirements for web application development using Bootstrap.

He provided insights about Bootstrap programming and its implementation. He explained them bootstrap architecture, its components and various resources. He not only explained it analytically but also demonstrated by creating demo webpages using bootstrap and shared with the students for further practice.
