RAGGING IN ANY FORM IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED

WHAT CONSTITUTES RAGGING?

Any act of deriving a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by the senior student over their junior resulting in

- Mental/physical/sexual abuse
- Verbal abuse
- Indecent behaviour
- Shame or torment or embarrassment
- Personal or public insult
- Annoyance or psychological harm
- Intimidation/wrongful restraint
- Financial exploitation/extortion
- Prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of a junior student
- Danger to health or person

PUNISHMENTS FOR RAGGING

If a student found guilty of ragging can lead to

- Suspension from attending classes
- Cancellation of admission
- Withholding/withdrawing scholarship and other benefits
- Debarring from appearing in exam/other evaluation process
- Withholding results
- Debarring from representing in festival or competition.
- Suspension from hostel
- Restriction from institution for a period of 1 to 4 years
- Expulsion from an institution and barring from admission in any other institution.
- Fine up to Rs. 25,000/-
- Lodging FIR with Police

10th January 2022










