Date: 5th April, 2023






Photo 1: One Day National E-Seminar on "Changing Scenario in Libraries & Librarianship".



As per directive from NSS department of Savitribai Phule Pune University We have completed online NSS unit proposal process before 15th Aug 2022.



Report of Visit to Red Cross School and District Disability Rehabilitation center


Activity: Visit to Red Cross School and District Disability Rehabilitation center, Silvassa

Objective: To encourage and help students learn the practical application of the subject.


The Department of Psychology organized a visit to the Red Cross School for Special Children and Red Cross Disability Rehabilitation center located opposite Sachivalya, Silvassa for T.Y.B.A students having Psychology special. Twenty-Nine students having special psychology visited both centers on 27th May 2022.



Students interacted with children having various psychological and physical problems like Hearing impairment, Visual impairment, Mental retardation, autism and Down syndrome, etc.




The aim of the visit was to provide practical knowledge to the students about their field and learn the techniques of complete observation and behavioral analysis. Most of the children in the school were intellectually disabled. Beginning with care group, the school has classes up to 10th std.



The Red Cross Society has a Rehabilitation center functioning for the welfare and well-being of disabled individuals. Psychological counseling, audio and speech therapy, sensory integration therapy is provided in the center. A clinical psychologist was there who gave brief knowledge about the children and the disorder they are suffering from and also shared details regarding their treatment and various improvements seen in their behavior.

Further, the students were permitted to meet all the students and interacted with them. As per symptoms studied in their special-1 Abnormal Psychology papers the symptoms of disorders and simultaneously their abnormal behavior was noticeable. Students got a good chance to have practical knowledge about the theories they studied during lectures. The students got aware of the practical aspect of the subject of psychology and gained information and knowledge about the working of these centers.





The visit was helpful to the students as they learned about the work of a psychologist and the functioning of mental health centers. The visit enhanced the knowledge of the students and helped them to see a clear picture of the theoretical things they have learned so far. They gained a deeper knowledge of mentally challenged students and gain insight into their subject.

8. Details of the programme:


